Saskatchewan Company Designs Technology to Lower the Danger of Stove Top Fires

SASKATOON, SASKATCHEWAN - Stove Guard International Ltd. (SGIL), a Saskatoon based company which manufactures and markets the Stove Guard product line of kitchen fire safety devices has expanded their product line.

Acting on the feedback received from Home Care Workers, Occupational Therapists and Fire Prevention Experts, the company has produced an upgraded Stove Guard Guardian Model. Aimed at lowering the danger of stove top fires, the product is designed to turn off the stove when left unattended.

The Consumer Product Safety Commission estimates that over 47,000 residential fires a year are started on range tops causing injuries to more than 2400 with around 80 fatalities and causing \$135 million in property damage. "Those alarming statistics are primarily due to fires being started when someone leaves a stovetop unattended. This has become the premise of this product," said Don Uhrich, President of Stove Guard International Ltd. He further added that "the need to decrease those numbers led to the development of the new Guardian Model, a product which combines features from all three previous Stove Guard models.
